We are delighted to announce our final trip of the year to the Yorkshire Wildlife Park on **Tuesday 5th July, 2022**.

Our topic this Summer term is all about looking after planet Earth, so this trip is going to provide an excellent opportunity to enhance our learning about animals and their habitats, as well as conservation efforts around the world. Whilst we are at the Yorkshire Wildlife Park, we are going to be participating in an educational workshop about Polar Bears, where we will learn about their adaptations, habitat, threats that Polar Bears face, and what we can do to help them. We will also have the opportunity to explore the Park through the day and learn all about how people are looking after animals around the world.

Please ensure that your child brings a packed lunch in a plastic disposable bag together with a drink in a plastic bottle as glass bottles are not permitted. If your child is entitled to a free school meal, please tick the box below if you would like us to provide a packed lunch. Please note that you will still need to provide a drink.
