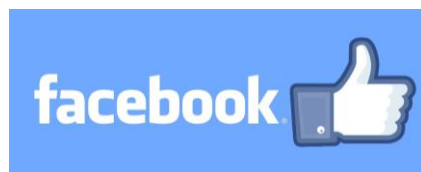

MY CHILD AT SCHOOL – OUR COMMUNICATION SYSTEM & NEW PAYMENT APP

As you will be aware, we have a new communication system in school, which includes messaging, the emailing of letters, as well as sending you updates/notifications.

All parents must download the 'My School at Child' app to access the system as well as access our school payment and booking system for all aspects of school e.g. school dinners, trips, after school clubs, parent permissions, parents' evenings etc,

All parents listed as priority one, who we hold a valid email address received an invite email and link to create an account. We now have 317 children with accounts meaning there's just under 40 children left. If you haven't created an account or require your log in details again, then please contact the school office.

All wraparound clubs can now be booked via the app and we have plenty of places available for both Breakfast Club & After School Club. Where possible, please book by each lunchtime, each Friday, for the following week.

As always, dinner money and club payments must be paid for in advance. Anyone who falls into arrears will be unable to book any further places or lunches. If you are ever struggling to pay, please speak to a member of the Office Staff or a Senior Leader.

PLEASE ENSURE YOU TURN THE APP NOTIFICATIONS ON TO RECEIVE ALL COMMUNICATIONS FROM SCHOOL.

Children walking home/Being collected by an elder sibling

A reminder that permission for your child to be collected by an elder sibling and which children in Years 5 & 6 are walking home by themselves must be given via the 'My Child at School' app. Please be vigilant when completing the consent form. You will need to click 'yes' to give consent for each statement. If you make an error, please contact the school office who will happily revoke. School are unable to double check if these permissions are correct – the responsibility lies with all parents/carers to provide the correct information.

A further reminder that any changes to your child's collection arrangement e.g. going home with a class friend, the school office or your child's Class Teacher, must be made aware beforehand.

Year 6 parents/carers - High School Applications

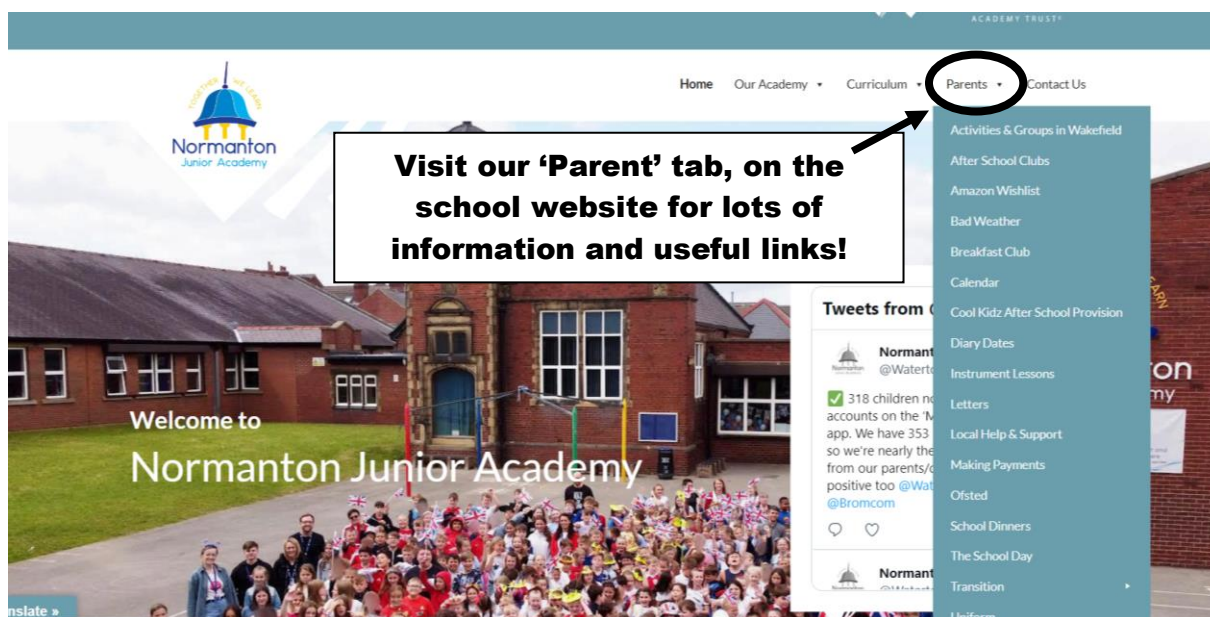

Drop Off Routine Reminders:

- School starts at 8:30am prompt and children should be lined up ready to be greeted by their Class Teacher
- The doors will close as soon as the last class is in school and therefore children who are late should come to the office doors.
- Please can parents stand around the edge of the playground once your child is in their line.
- Staff can take very brief messages etc but if more in-depth conversations are required, please arrange an appointment with your child's Class Teacher.
- Please ensure that no children access the trim trails or tyres before or after school as these are unsupervised by staff.

Home Time Routine Reminders:

- Years 3 & 4 will be released from separate doors, as follows:
 - 3EJ & 4RT – The double main doors on the playground
 - 4PB – From the left-hand side hall fire exit doors
 - 4OB – From the right-hand side hall fire exit doors
 - 3HB & 3EW – From the fire exit door near the main entrance gate (near the tyres)
- Please can parents stand around the edge of the playground or evenly spaced so all parents can collect their child safely.
- Staff are available to speak to parents once they have distributed all children.
