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Behaviour Passport Information for Parents/Carers

Dear Parents/Carers,

On Friday, your child brought home a paper copy of our newly designed Behaviour Passport which will provide you with all the information and criteria for your child to achieve their Bronze and/or Silver award by Easter (end of the Spring Term) and Gold award by July.

The criteria for a Bronze award are as follows:

HOMEWORK	I have regularly completed homework over a full term.
ATTENDANCE	I have attended school 95% of the time or more for one term.
PUNCTUALITY	I have been late for less than 2% of the term.
RESPECT FOR SCHOOL	I consistently show respect for my resources.
READING	I have read at least 3 times per week this term.
BEHAVIOUR IN LESSONS	I am regularly on the recognition board.
BEHAVIOUR OUTSIDE	I am well-behaved during break times.

The criteria for a Silver award are as follows:

HOMEWORK	I have regularly completed homework over 2 terms
ATTENDANCE	I have attended school 95% of the time for two terms or 100% for a term.
PUNCTUALITY	I have been late for less than 2% of 2 terms or 0% for 1 term.
RESPECT FOR SCHOOL	I consistently show respect for my resources and classroom.
READING	I have read at least 3 times per week this term.
HELPING AT HOME	I have helped at home at least once a week this term.
BEHAVIOUR IN LESSONS	I have achieved A or B for all effort grades over a term.
BEHAVIOUR OUTSIDE	I am well-behaved during break times.
ACTIVITY LIST	I have completed 5 activities from my passport.

Note:

- To achieve the Silver and Gold award, some of the criteria involve support from home.
- Each year group have their own activity lists to complete. (These are not completed directly in school).
- For your child to achieve their Gold award by the end of the academic year, they will need to complete their entire activity list, as well as organise and carry out a fundraising event for a charity.

As you will see, the expectations to achieve a Bronze award are in line with what we would expect from all pupils on a day-to-day basis. To achieve a Silver award, this must be maintained and the completion of 5 activities within their passport must be completed.

In previous years, the attendance criterion has been 96% or above, but this has been changed to 95% this academic year in line with the new national average.

We are aware that some children will have been disappointed that they were unable to achieve their Bronze award and attend last week's awards ceremony. We appreciate they may have missed out on their Bronze award last term, due to attendance or the amount of home reading completed, for example. However, don't worry - there is still ample opportunity for all children to achieve their Bronze, Silver and Gold badge this academic year. It is possible for children to achieve their Bronze and Silver Award this term.

Please note - that the attendance and home reading criteria have been set in such a way that Silver is still achievable during the Spring Term regardless of figures for the Autumn Term.

If you lose your child's paper copy of their passport then please contact your child's class teacher for another copy.
