Dear Parents/Carers

We have some very exciting news! Miss Jones, Miss Wood and Mrs Griffiths are delighted to announce that Year 3 have the opportunity to attend **two educational trips** in May.

Countryside Classrooms

Our first trip will take place on **Wednesday 3rd May 2023**. Year 3 will heading-off to Ledston to experience a day in the wilderness. The trip is aimed to develop key transferable life skills such as: co-operation, resilience, communication, and concentration. Throughout the duration of the day, Year 3 will complete the following activities: The Country Code featuring the dogs and a ferret, meet and learn about the sheep, bird feeders, den building, scavenger hunt and animal poo that's made by you!



The workshop is free charge and there will be a cost of £9.00 per child to cover transport.

Murton Park

This trip will be split over two days. Please see below:

- **Monday 22nd May – 3HB and half of 3EJ (surnames A to G)**
- **Tuesday 23rd May- 3EW and half of 3EJ (surnames H to Z).**



We are going to Murton Park to live a day in the life of a new recruit in the Roman Army! Children will get the chance to take part in workshops such as military skills, making an oil lamp and finding their way around a Roman fort.

The cost for the Murton Park trip is £29 per child. This covers the cost of the coach and the workshops throughout the day.

For both events, please ensure that your child brings a packed lunch in a plastic disposable bag together with a drink in a plastic bottle as glass bottles are not permitted. If your child is entitled to a free school meal, please inform the school office if you would like us to provide a packed lunch. Please note that you will still need to provide a drink.

If your child suffers from travel sickness, or has any medical conditions that we need to be aware of, they will need to bring all relevant medications with them on the day in a clearly labelled bag. If your child has an inhaler in school, their class teacher will take this with them on the day.

The total cost per pupil, for both trips, is £38. This will cover the coach travel, admission to both events, and the educational workshops. We are acutely aware of the financial pressures' families are under currently and this is why we have tried to ensure that parts of the trips are subsidised or are in fact free! If you are not in a position to pay before the trip takes place, please contact the school office.

We can confirm that the coach is fully seat-belted. To ensure that the trip can go ahead, we kindly ask for your co-operation by giving consent and making payment via the via the MCAS app.

Please can we remind you that in the event of insufficient contributions received, the visit will have to be cancelled in line with the school policy.
