Who are we?

- ◆ We are Inclusion/Advisory Teachers and specialist non-teaching staff
- ◆ We have experience and knowledge of SEND in mainstream and specialist education settings; we use this to support your child's setting.
- ◆ Each setting has a named Inclusion/Advisory teacher as their point of contact.
- ◆ Our staff work across a 'cluster area' of the local authority. Each teacher has a group of settings where they are the first point of contact.
- ◆ We use our experience and knowledge to help settings decide what to do now and how to support in the future .
- ◆ We help support the child or young person to take part and have their voice heard.
- ◆ We work closely with other agencies and professionals to help meet children's needs. (EYFS, Schools and Post 16)

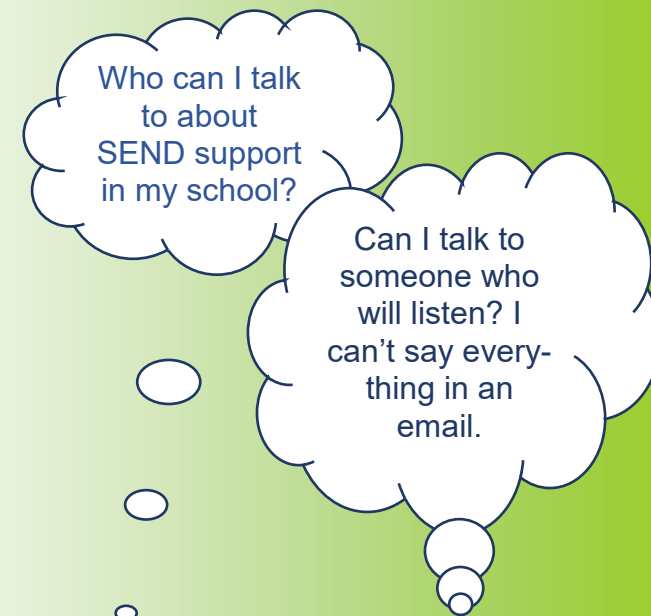


In addition to the service we provide to all schools and setting across Wakefield WISENDSS are pleased to announce our new parent helpline. **WISENDSS CONNECT**
