

## Year 4 Residential Trip

Dear Parents and Carers.

We have some exciting news! Following a very successful Year 6 London trip this year, we are excited to announce that we have provisionally booked a Year 4 residential trip for April 2024!

Prior to the Covid pandemic, children had the opportunity to attend a residential trip in year 4 and year 6. We are finally able to re-start the residential trips safely.

We have carefully chosen a provider who can accommodate the whole of Year 4, to allow every child the opportunity to go.

The children will visit PGL Newby Wiske Hall, Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> – Friday 19<sup>th</sup> April 2024. See below for more details.

The cost for the trip is £225 per child. We will require a £40 deposit to secure your child's place, followed by the below instalments:

£40.00 to be paid by Friday 6<sup>th</sup> October 2023 £30.00 to be paid by Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> November 2023

£30.00 to be paid by Friday 1st December 2023

£30.00 to be paid by Friday 5th January 2024

£30.00 to be paid by Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> February 2024

£30.00 to be paid by Friday 1st March 2024

£35.00 to be paid by Friday 5th April 2024

All payments are **non-refundable** unless a place is cancelled under exceptional circumstances. In this case it will be refunded at the schools' discretion.

The trip is live on MCAS to book and make payments as outlined above. The £40 deposit, by **Friday 6<sup>th</sup> October**, will confirm your child's place and parental permission for your child to attend.

Please note - this is based on the anticipation that at least 40 children will be going on the trip. If we receive lower numbers than 40, the trip may have to be cancelled.

Any children who do not attend the residential will be expected to attend school as normal.

If you have any questions, or would like to discuss the trip in further detail, please contact Mrs Tintor or one of the Year 4 teachers. We would love as many children to attend as possible so no question, query or concern will be unnecessary.
