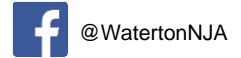
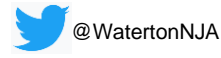

### Year 6 School Trip – The Holocaust Exhibition and Learning Centre

We have some very exciting news! Mr Siddle, Miss Massa and Mr Clune are delighted to announce that Year 6 have the opportunity to visit The Holocaust Exhibition and Learning Centre.

The centre have a travel subsidy scheme which allows free transport to and from the Centre, however there will be a cost of **£13** per child, to cover the cost of the workshops provided by the learning centre.

The trip will take place over three days. Please see below:

- 6SM – **Monday 25<sup>th</sup> September**
- 6OS – **Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> September**
- 6MC – **Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> September**



With our topic this Autumn being 'World War II', the children have an amazing opportunity to visit **The Holocaust Exhibition and Learning Centre** in Huddersfield (University Campus). The children will be provided with the opportunity to speak and listen to Holocaust survivors and refugees who came together in the spirit of friendship and mutual support to create 'The Holocaust Survivors' Friendship Association'. On the day, the children will participate in activities to support and solidify their understanding of World War 2 and develop key understanding through first-hand experiences.

For the trip, please ensure that your child brings a **packed lunch** in a plastic disposable bag together with a drink in a plastic bottle as glass bottles are not permitted.

**If your child is entitled to a free school meal, please inform the school office ASAP to order a school packed lunch. Please note that you will still need to provide a drink.**

If your child suffers from travel sickness, or has any medical conditions that we need to be aware of, please speak to your child's class teacher or the school office before the trip. Children will need to bring all relevant medications with them on the day in a clearly labelled bag. If your child has an inhaler in school, their class teacher will take this with them on the day.

To ensure that the trip can go ahead, we kindly ask for your co-operation in paying the voluntary contribution before Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> September via the My Child at School app.

We fully appreciate the short notice of this trip, as it is taking part at the beginning of term. If any families are unable to make the payment before the required date, please contact Mrs Tintor or Mr Welsh to discuss further. We would love all children to have the opportunity to attend the trip to enhance their learning of the World War II topic and will do our very best to assist in any financial difficulties.

**Please can we remind you that in the event of insufficient contributions received, the visit will have to be cancelled in line with the school policy.**
